- ▶ Gain an understanding of the public and private operations within Allegany County and the state of Maryland.
- ▶ Gain a deeper understanding of the issues endemic to the region by observing and hearing the views of others.
- ▶ Programs are engineered for class participation and dialogue and cover such topics as: Arts and Entertainment, Economic Development, Education, Environment, Health Care, Human Services, Local and State Government.

CLASS OF 2024 APPLICATION

Tuition & Program Commitment

Tuition for the 2024 Program will be **\$1,500.00 plus a \$25.00 application fee** and may be paid by the individual or the sponsoring institution. Tuition is due prior to orientation. A limited number of partial scholarships will be available to individuals who might otherwise be unable to participate.

Participation

In order to accomplish the objectives of the program, the full participation of each class member is necessary. Participation includes:

Orientation - Wednesday, September 27, 2023 beginning at 9am through Thursday, September 28, 2023 ending at 5pm. **Full attendance is mandatory.**

State Government Day - Tuesday, March 12 at 8am through Wednesday, March 13 at 6pm in Annapolis, MD. **Full attendance is mandatory.**

Equivalent of one full day per month. Class normally meets the second Wednesday of each month; please see schedule on this page. Participants will be permitted to miss one full session or the equivalent of one full session, not including Orientation and State Government Day.

Application & Selection Process

Participants will be selected from a diverse mix of the local population - business, the professions, government, education, religious and civic groups, the arts and organized labor. Applications are encouraged from all segments of the community.

Candidates will be chosen by a Selection Committee; class size is limited. Each candidate will be evaluated by criteria that takes diversity, community involvement, and demonstrated potential leadership capabilities into consideration.

All applications will be handled in the strictest confidence. Special emphasis should be given to any question you feel will significantly add to the Committee's knowledge of your qualifications.

Participants in the Leadership Allegany Class of 2024 will be selected from those individuals who have submitted a completed Application Form by June 23, 2023. To assist the Selection Committee, we request the forms be typed or printed legibly.

Completing your Leadership Allegany Application:

- ▶ Read Application and Selection Process sections thoroughly.
- ▶ Include Letter of Recommendation and Resume or Bio.
- ▶ Include \$25.00 non-refundable application fee, paid by applicant.
- ▶ Do not send checks to cover tuition now. Accepted participants will be billed their tuition.
- ▶ Applications must be post-marked by June 23, 2023.
- ▶ All applicants will be notified of their status by August 11, 2023.
- ▶ Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
